



Stations 1 & 2 members and an attorney to discuss a new Fireman's building. He also reported that he received A copy of the letter that was sent to the New York State Comptroller for Storrs Road Water Project and conformation that the Comptrollers Office received it. Also, a proposed Emergency Response Plan has been compiled by Jeff Kenney and will soon be sent to Rural Development with other items that were listed in a letter from Carol McDonald, USDA, Rural Development.

C'man Cobb reported that the Planning Board is still working on an amendment to the Zoning Law for Rt. 3, but they are also looking at changes they would like to make town wide also.

C'man Lawrence reported that he has a date of 4/4/07 at 10:30 AM to meet with Greg Burnell for review of our Emergency Plan. Ken also would like to sit down with the Sackets Harbor Chief of Police to see what he would like to see happen in the future for the Police Dept. Possibly the Village and Town Boards could meet on this issue. C'man Lee said that he would like C'man Lawrence to wrap up the road standards report from last year.

C'man Crescenzi reported that the Planning Board would like to meet with the Highway Superintendent about road standards. He also reported that Time Warner will be conducting surveys about cable on the Military Road and NYS Rt. 180. C'man Crescenzi also gave a report on the last Planning Board Meeting.

The Town received a letter from the mayor of Brownville, thanking the Highway Department for its help with a water leak in that village a few weeks ago.

At this time the Highway Superintendent's Report was given by Bruce Alcombrack.

A Water Department report was given by Jeff Kenney.

A Zoning Officer's Report was given by Marlene Lennox.

An Assessor's Report was given by Jean Rogers.

The Supervisor's Report was given: Total Receipts - \$749,640.59  
Total Disbursements - \$675,538.68  
Bank Balances - \$120,058.97  
Total Investments - \$557,796.00

A motion was made by C'man Cobb and 2<sup>nd</sup> by C'man Crescenzi to accept the Supervisor's Report. All voted aye and the motion was carried.

A note from Supervisor Derouin said that the Town web site is still being designed but should be available soon.

Legislator Barry Ormsby was present with an update on the Airport progress such as renovations to the terminal, a new carrier, adding flights to Boston and Albany, and adding 25-28 permanent jobs.

A report for the East Hounsfield Library was given by Sandy Farrington, Library Manager and Jay Rivest, Treasurer. Proposed activities and renovations at the Library were mentioned and an Annual Financial Report was given to the Town Board.

The floor was opened for public comment at this time. A question was asked about Bed Tax applications and C'man Lee informed everyone that those applications are at the Town Clerk's Office. Other comments were about water districts and emergency plans.

Jeremy Rogers was present and asked about the opening of the portion of Slater Road that is not being used now and the Highway Superintendent said that this road was never abandoned and it is mainly a safety issue for plowing. If this portion was reconstructed, the plows could access all of Slater Road from Fields Road. The plan is to start cutting brush this year but it may be a two or three year project. Mr. Rogers presented the Board with a petition from residents of the road that have concerns.

Lori Keegan was present with concerns of a new fireman's building at Sulphur Springs. She asked if it would be possible to have the new building centrally located so Fire Co. 1 & 2 could use it and maybe they could save money. C'man Lee said he would pass these comments on to the Fire Dept. A study on this topic has been conducted and will be reviewed by the Board of Directors soon.

A motion was made by C'man Lee and 2<sup>nd</sup> by C'man Cobb to pay an extra bill for rental of a mower tractor out of the equipment fund. All voted aye and this motion was carried.

C'man Lee asked all councilmen to form a 5 yr. plan of what they would like to see happen in the Highway Department.

C'man Lee also invited anyone to come to a walk through at the Highway Building this Friday, 3/16, at 2 PM.

This meeting was adjourned at 8:23 PM.
