## Rabies Vaccination Clinics for Dogs, Cats and Ferrets



At Least Three months of age or older *EVEN* if your pet is an *INDOOR* pet it **MUST** be vaccinated against Rabies

*The Law states - If unvaccinated pet bites/scratches someone - the OWNER MUST pay for confinement in approved kennel for 10 days*

### **PLEASE NOTE!**

- ▶ Animals initially need two shots, one year apart, then once every three years.
- ▶ **Bring a copy of your pet's last certificate** AND/or a paper with the following information: Owner's name, street/road address, town of residence, phone, each pet name, weight (over/under 20 lbs), sex, breed, age, and color.
- ▶ Dogs must be **LEASHED**. Cats and Ferrets must be **CONTAINED** in a strong fiber sack, box, or picnic basket.
- ▶ Public Health requests a \$10.00 donation to assist in defraying free clinic expenses.
